Code of Ethics

Ethical requirements of all members of the AVVRG are as follows;

- a. Respect the customs and beliefs of all peoples they encounter and not attempt to enforce their religious beliefs on any individual or group.
- b. Accept the rights of individuals to hold a different point of view.
- c. Provide appropriate assistance to the best of their ability as a volunteer, without restriction in regard to race, religion, politics and social status.
- d. Maintain at all times the highest standard of professionalism.
- e. Recognise the extent and limitations of their professional abilities and expertise and not go beyond these boundaries.
- f. Ensure work is based on the need of the community in which they are working.
- g. Support and promote the fundamental principles of the organisation.
- h. Refer to a senior member of the organisation any problem that is beyond their capacity to resolve.
- i. Not disclose inappropriately any personal information entrusted to them.
- j. Be familiar with the Rules and By-Laws of the AVVRG as published on the AVVRG website.
- k. Act in a way that maintains or enhances the standing of the organisation within the community.
- l. Be aware that behaviour considered unacceptable or damaging to the name or welfare of the organisation, may result in a motion of censure by the AVVRG National Management Committee and other action as deemed appropriate.
